Job Description:

20 hours per week – additional hours may be requested

Tuesday – Friday

Occasional Saturday

Tuesday & Thursday are teaching days.

Two classes are held each Tuesday & Thursday. 10:00 – Noon & 1:00 – 3:00.

Approx. 6-7 hours each Tuesday & Thursday.

Wednesday is a day for project prep and sample making. Hours are flexible for prep work.

Friday - a morning art program will be taught at a local resort from 10 – 11:30. (Approx. 3 hours total time).

Intern Responsibilities:

The Summer Internship Program for LOLA will focus on art classes primarily for children ages 7 and up, with adults welcome and encouraged. (Generally, a parent or grand-parent.) LOLA Programming Director or other LOLA representative will supervise and work with the intern to formulate all aspects of classes.

This will include, but is not limited to:

- Creating class offerings & lesson plans with LOLA Programming Director
- Lead and teach classes
- Create samples of all projects
- Research and prep for each class
- Clean up after classes and keep art room presentable and ready for next class
- Act as a LOLA representative to the public visiting the LOLA Center for the Arts
