Teaching Internship

LOLA is looking for an intern to teach 3 weeks,
(dates negotiable between mid-June through beginning of August)
of theatre activities to children, ending with a performance on the last day.

Intern Responsibilities:

The Summer Theatre Internship Program for LOLA will focus on working with children ages 7 through 16, in a variety of classes/activities/rehearsals that introduce students to acting, singing or dance, which build up to a live short performance at the end of the 3 weeks. LOLA Programming Director or other LOLA representative will supervise and work with the intern to formulate all aspects of this program. Intern will be the creative director of this program.

Job Description:

Approximately 24 hours per week – additional hours may be requested
Monday - Thursday (Schedule to be determined with intern & LOLA representative)
With the last Friday of the period being the recital/performance

This will include, but is not limited to:

- Creating class offerings & lesson plans with LOLA Programming Director
- Lead and teach classes
- Research and prep for each class
- Act as a LOLA representative to the public & parents of children taking classes

- Develop leadership skills
- Gain an effective approach to working with young people
- Meet teaching goals & deadlines
- A chance to be creative
- Develop communication skills
- Stipend given to the accepted candidate (\$200 per week)
