



Sandra Hardy Brown Summer 2021 Art Teaching Internship

LOLA Arts is seeking an intern to teach 7 weeks of Art Classes for Children and Adults, starting June 28 through August 13, 2021.

The Summer Art Teaching Intern will teach art classes primarily to children ages 7 and up, with adults welcome and encouraged. (Generally, a parent or grand-parent.) The LOLA Executive Director or other LOLA representative will supervise and work with the intern to formulate all aspects of classes. The intern is encouraged to conclude their internship with an art display of their own work at LOLA Arts.

The intern will be offered free housing in the LOLA Arts apartment and earn a stipend of \$200 per week. Many opportunities for other part-time supplemental income are available in the area. There also are plenty of nearby places to enjoy the outdoors. Applicants should have completed at least one year of college/technical school and have experience/expertise in the visual arts.

Responsibilities:

- 24-30 hours per week – additional hours may be requested
- Tuesday – Friday with an occasional Saturday
- Morning and afternoon classes are taught on Tuesday and Thursdays
- Project prep and sample making will be done on Wednesdays and Fridays
- Clean up after classes and keep art room presentable and ready for next class
- Act as a LOLA representative to the public visiting the LOLA Center for the Arts

- Hands-on classroom teaching experience with children & adults
- Develop leadership skills
- Gain an effective approach to working with young people
- Set and meet teaching goals
- Meet deadlines
- A chance to be creative and make art
- Develop communication skills
