



Summer 2024 Theater Teaching Internship

LOLA Arts is seeking an intern to teach drama activities to children for 8 weeks, starting June 17 through August 9, 2024.

The Summer Theater Intern will be the creative director of a theater program for children ages 7 through 16. LOLA Arts Executive Director or other LOLA Arts representative will supervise and work with the intern to formulate all aspects of this program. The intern will be offered free housing in the LOLA Arts Apartment and earn a stipend of \$200 per week. Many opportunities for other part-time supplemental income are available in the area. There are also plenty of nearby places to enjoy the outdoors. Applicants should have completed at least one year of college/technical school and have experience/expertise in theater and/or creative writing.

Responsibilities:

- 24-30 work hours per week – additional hours may be requested
- Monday - Friday (Schedule to be determined with intern & LOLA Arts representative)
- Act as a LOLA representative to the public visiting the LOLA Center for the Arts

Internship Outcomes:

- hands-on classroom teaching experience with children
- develop leadership skills
- gain an effective approach to working with young people
- set and meet teaching goals
- meet deadlines
- develop communication skills

Students who take theatre classes at LOLA Arts will:

- experience a variety of theatrical styles and activities
- gain confidence, focus, and concentration
- use creativity, body language, and imagination through role-playing
- have accountability, determination, and teamwork
- use problem-solving and learn to receive constructive feedback
- experience the freedom of expression in a safe, relaxed, and fun atmosphere
- have fun, socialize & learn to love theater
